



Working Through Transportation Regulations

Course Overview

This course aims to steer transporters and other people involved in cattle transportation, auction market employees for instance. It explains the transportation regulation in three parts: cattle behaviour and handling, transportation steps and preparation and risk management.

Who Should Take the Course?

Dairy calves and cull cattle transporters, Auction workers, producers, including professionals, small transporters, animal merchants and producers/transporters. All people interested and involved in cattle transportation, especially those involved in the transportation of cull cattle and dairy calves.

Course Objectives

This module is an introduction to guide the participant in its responsibility towards the transportation regulation and the risk assessment. It also contains recommendations regarding the management of these potential risks.
